Guidance Notes

Fishing membership of the Irish Disabled Fly Fishing Association is restricted to -

1. Anglers who have a physical impairment eg. spinal injury, cerebral palsy, amputee, polio, spina bifida, congenital deformity or severe arthritis etc. ALL anglers must demonstrate a lack of function or a physical impairment that restricts them from competing on equal terms with non-disabled anglers-

2. Anglers who are blind.

It is stressed that the Association wishes to encourage the involvement of those anglers whose disability is obvious. An invisible handicap is not a disqualification for entry. However where an angler, with an invisible handicap, feels that he/she needs the facilities provided by the Association the Committee will be prepared to consider an application for membership. Selection for the team to compete in the ***Disabled International Competition*** is restricted to anglers with a physical disability.

Associate membership is open to anyone willing to act as a helper in any way.
